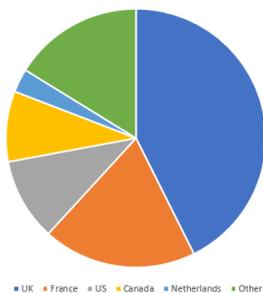

Chair's update

Current membership

PW reported the group's current membership as below:

PW explained that the membership numbers were based on number of active email addresses when meeting invitations were sent out. PW maintains the list and handles requests for additions, removals, or modifications. Bounced emails resulted in members being automatically considered inactive.

Common file format

PW reported that the *UT Data Common File Format* group led by TM at EPRI had selected the ONDE format developed by COFREND (France) as the basis for subsequent development. ONDE is part-based on MFMC but is ultimately intended to cover all NDE modalities. Some concepts on naming semantics are being developed with advice from Steve Holland (Iowa State University, ISU) based on his experience with the ISU ANDE format. PW summarised the main differences between ONDE and MFMC and outlined what the final output of the initiative would look like. TM noted that potential users could view the current documents on the Github repository:
