During the introduction, **PW** announced that he would be taking forward the work that Martin Mienczakowski did on producing a common file format for FMC.

After the “around the call introduction” was given, the meeting moved to the BINDT FMC user group terms of reference.

For reference, these include:

1. *Production of a guide of agreed terminology*
2. *Review of existing techniques for calibration for FMC inspection and recommendation of best practice*
3. *The FMC common file format for raw data*
4. *A common file format for reconstructed data with links to the raw data format*

TB mentioned that he had read through some of the documentation that the FMC user group had already produced. It seemed that some work on the terms of reference had been done, where the content of the spec ref: BS EN1330-4 2010, had been amended to include more FMC specific terms. At this stage it wasn't clear whether an update to the ISO standard would be required, or whether an entirely new standard surrounding FMC terminology would be needed. **NSw** mentioned that the content of this standard may be subject to non-disclosure and shouldn't be distributed. **NSw** would contact CEN committee about distribution of info in the standard. *(Post meeting note: a search has found this standard to have been withdrawn by BSi).*

Next it was discussed to find a distinction between FMC, FMC data and file format. **NSw** proposed that a MFMC-CCF specification previously done by Martin Mienczakowski on standardizing full matrix capture data should be disclosed publicly. However, **PW** wanted to make sure the latest documents were sent out; these were currently sitting on the University google drive. **PW** and **TB** agreed to meet post-meeting to look at information prior to sending it out publicly.

Action TB: To arrange suitable meeting with PW.





Next the possibility of hosting a Beta version of an FMC best working practice/standard at BINDT as was proposed.

TB mentioned that another meeting was already planned in early June, to include those who missed the first meeting. It will now also be used to follow up on the review of Martin's documentation.

TB closed the meeting.
