## MSc Advanced Industrial Practice (NDT)

This is an exciting new programme that is aimed specifically towards those working in positions of responsibility within NDT, CM and SHM who want to develop their expertise within their current profession. The programme also benefits the employer in terms of workplace projects and product development.

- **Duration of programme:**  
2-5 years.
- **Start dates:**  
January, May and October.
- **Mode of delivery:**  
Work-based blended learning.
- **Entry requirements:**  
Incorporated/Chartered Engineer (NDT).

### Key features

- Distance learning MSc degree
- Two-and-a-half-year programme
- Proven delivery model
- Low-cost degree – *circa* £4000 for the complete programme
- Takes into account historic experiential learning
- First year managed by BINDT – *circa* six months
- First year based on experiential learning linked to IEng registration
- Second year based on one or two workplace projects of the employer/student's choosing
- Third year based on a research project of the employer/student's choosing
- IEng achieved during the programme; 'CEng ready' by the end of the programme.
